- We developed a measuring tool to show the richness of Adult daycare (ADC) service experiences (The J-AdaCa Tool). The tool asked ADC staff to evaluate their clients' 17 kind experiences with its frequency. The survey was conducted in 17 ADC agencies in the metropolitan area, then we obtained data from 360 clients. Principal component analysis showed four factors and their component scores, regarding the experience of ADC use: "Social participation", "Hygiene and health", "Exercise and eating habits", and "Family support".
